For Immediate Release to Water System Customers

Village of Folsom may experience problems with the water supply system due to a broken water line on St. John Road on 02/25/2019 at 2:00 PM. Repair will begin after Dottie locates all utility lines. This Boil Water Advisory will include all of the following:

All Residents on St. John Road

Because of this potential repair, the water produced by our water supply system may be of questionable microbiological quality.

Therefore, as a **precaution**, we are issuing an extended BOIL ADVISORY effective beginning 02/25/2019 at 2:00 PM. This BOIL ADVISORY is to remain in effect until rescinded by your government officials of Village of Folsom and DHH.

It is recommended that all consumers disinfect their water before consuming it including fountain drinks, making ice, brushing teeth, or using it for food preparation or rinsing of foods by the following means:

Boil water for one (1) *full* minute in a clean container. The one minute starts after the water has been brought to a rolling boil. (The flat taste can be eliminated by shaking the water in a clean bottle, pouring it from one clean container to another, or by adding a small pinch of salt to each quart of water that is boiled.)

Again, please be sure to disinfect your own water prior to consumption until you have been advised otherwise.

Village of Folsom will rescind this Boil Advisory upon notification from the Louisiana Department of Health and Hospitals - Office of Public Health that additional water samples collected from our water supply system have shown our water to be safe.
