**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 31, SECTION 31.7
REVOKING PORTIONS OF AUSTIN, GORDON AND JACKSON STREETS
AND ALLEYS IN SQUARES 110, 111, 122, 123 AND 124, VILLAGE OF FOLSOM**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Aldermen of the Village of Folsom, State of Louisiana that the dedication of the public streets indicated below be and the same are hereby revoked and said streets are declared permanently closed, abandoned and no longer needed for public purposes:

That portion of Austin Street lying between the southernmost right-of-way line of Garfield Street and the northernmost right-of-way line of Jackson Street.

That portion of Gordon Street lying between the easternmost right-of-way line of Pearl Street (also known as Peach Street) and the westernmost right-of-way line of Olive Street.


That portion of Jackson Street lying between the easternmost right-of-way line of Pearl Street (also known as Peach Street) and the westernmost right-of-way line of Austin Street.


BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Aldermen of the Village of Folsom, State of Louisiana that the dedication of the twenty (20.0') alleys running north and south and bisecting Squares 110, 111, 122, 123 and 124, Village of Folsom, be and the same are hereby revoked and said alleys are declared permanently closed, abandoned and no longer needed for public purposes.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall take effect on and after its promulgation.




