

## CHAPTER 32

### DONATIONS

#### Section 32.1 Library Site

(a) The Village of Folsom, hereby donates a parcel of land from the Village of Folsom for a St. Tammany Parish Library. That parcel of land is described as follows and as depicted on the survey of Land Surveying, Inc. Jeron R. Fitzmorris, Registered Land Surveyor, dated July 17, 1984, No. 3587:

Being located in the Village of Folsom, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana.

From the Northeast Corner of Square 102, Town of Folsom, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana formed by the intersection of Canton Street and Railroad Avenue, this being the point of beginning.

From the point of beginning, run in a Northeasterly direction on the South right-of-way of Canton Street 150.0 feet to a point; thence run in a Southeasterly direction parallel to the East side of Square 102, 200.0 feet to a point; thence run in a southwesterly direction parallel to Canton Street 150.0 feet to a point; thence run in a Northwesterly direction along the East right-of-way of Square 102, 200.0 feet back to the point of beginning.

This tract contains 0.69 acres, more or less.

(b) The donation of the above described parcel is conditioned upon the parcel being used exclusively for the construction and maintenance of a Parish Branch Library by the St. Tammany Parish Library Board of Control. Should the parcel not be used for such purpose either originally or at any future date, then said parcel shall revert back to the Village of Folsom.
