The meeting was called to order and a quorum established. The invocation and pledge were led by Alderman Donald Burris. The Agenda and financial statements were approved on motion of Alderman Burris, seconded by Alderman Willie. The motion carried. (3 Yeas, 0 Nays)

**New Business:**

**Item I = Contract for Garbage Services:**

Mayor Bickham stated that our garbage contract service went back up for bid. We had two bids with twice a week pick service, Progressive bid \$13.65 and Team Waste bid \$13.44. Mayor stated that ordinarily contract usually goes to lowest bid or what the board accepts. Motion made by Alderman Burris to accept the garbage contract pick-up twice a week from Team Waste, second by Alderman Willie. (3 Yeas, 0 Nays) The Motion carried.


Mayor commented that he will meet with Team Waste manger Stephen Lytton this week in order to go over details with the contract and start pick-up service in August 2014. Alderman Willie asked what days will garbage be pick-up? Mr. Lytton stated same days Monday and Thursday. There were a few questions from local residents and the Mayor briefly replied to their concerns.

Mayor Bickham asked, if there were any announcements, Alderman Burris introduced Attorney Roy Burns, whom then introduced himself as running for D.A. for St. Tammany and Washington Parishes. Mr. Burns spoke briefly about his candidacy and running for position. Mr. Ken Wilt then asked if we could work

on our ordinances on the main highway, about keeping properties maintained and keeping grass cut. Mr. Bread another residence from Folsom commented about a lot in Village Trace that needs to be cut also. Mayor Bickham stated these complaints's need to come to him and he is unaware of these issues. Another resident asked about the cleaning of abandoned and collapse trailers and the burnt Shell station and has concerns about the safety of our community. Mayor stated that we have to take proper procedures but it is being handled.

The meeting was adjourned on motion of Alderman Burris, seconded by Alderman Willie. (3 Yeas, 0 Nays) Motion carried.
