


Village of Folsom MWPP RESOLUTION

Resolved that the Village of Folsom informs Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality that the following actions were taken by the Village Board (governing body).

1. Reviewed the Municipal Water Pollution Prevention Environmental Audit Report which is attached to this resolution.
2. Set forth the following actions necessary to maintain permit requirements contained in the Louisiana Water Discharge Permit System (LPDES) number LA0064378.
 - a. Continue to train current employee as a certified operator for system operation and provide 16 hours of training per operator over the next year. This training will be conducted thru outside training sessions. Continue contract with operation company for additional assistance.
 - b. Minimize INI flow to the system by proper sewer collection planning and future projects.
 - c. Continue to operate Sewer Plant and insure Permit compliance. Have no LPDES Excursions during 2018 and handle all bio-solids in the de-watering system.
 - d. Collect monthly Influent samples for Annual Audit.
 - e. Initiate sludge removal via the required LPDES sludge permit. Follow new Bio-solids Permit.
 - f. Investigate new procedures for solids handling at the facility including investigating a more cost effective method of solids disposal.
