Item 1 – Ordinance No 2020-2 Chapter 33 Amending the Operating Budget of Revenue and Expenditures for FY 20-21

Mayor Willie read Ordinance, there were no comments.

Item 2 – Giddy Up Coffee House –Claire Pendergast

Mayor Willie introduced Claire Pendergast.

Ms. Pendergast introduced herself stating she currently lives in Mandeville, but is interested in moving out to Folsom to be more a part of this community. Ms. Pendergast explained that for the past year she has owned and operated an Arts Collective that focused on offering a platform for artist, educators, and entrepreneurs, providing studio space, workshops, and freelance opportunities. Ms. Pendergast mentioned that she attended LSU and expressed that she is here in Folsom to support the community and would like to help develop an Arts District in the Village of Folsom, expressing that she considers herself an arts advocate.

Ms. Pendergast further explained, that Giddy Up will be hosting a Market on every Monday of each month, with various vendors. She stated that is a soft introduction to the Market, which will allow them to test the event to see how it develops.

In concluding Ms. Pendergast informed the board that she and the owners of Giddy Up would like to start a nonprofit organization called Wholesome Folsom.
