

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AND ENACTING A NEW CODE FOR THE VILLAGE OF FOLSOM, LOUISIANA; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES NOT INCLUDED THEREIN; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; PROVIDING FOR THE MANNER OF AMENDING SUCH CODE; AND PROVIDING WHEN SUCH CODE AND THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE VILLAGE OF FOLSOM:

Section 1. The Code entitled "Code of Ordinances, Village of Folsom, Louisiana," published by Municipal Code Corporation, consisting of chapters 1 through 40, each inclusive, is adopted.

Section 2. All ordinances of a general and permanent nature enacted on or before March 12, 2018, and not included in the Code or recognized and continued in force by reference therein, are repealed.

Section 3. The repeal provided for in Section 2 hereof shall not be construed to revive any ordinance or part thereof that has been repealed by a subsequent ordinance that is repealed by this ordinance.

Section 4. Unless another penalty is expressly provided, every person convicted of a violation of any provision of the Code or any ordinance, rule or regulation adopted or issued in pursuance thereof shall be punished by a fine not exceeding \$500.00, imprisonment for a term not exceeding 60 days, or both such fine and imprisonment. Except as otherwise provided: (i) With respect to violations of this Code that are continuous with respect to time, each day the violation continues is a separate offense. (ii) With respect to other violations of this Code, each act of violation constitutes a separate offense. The penalty provided by this section, unless another penalty is expressly provided, shall apply to the amendment of any Code section, whether or not such penalty is reenacted in the amendatory ordinance. In addition to the penalty prescribed above, they may pursue other remedies such as abatement of nuisances, injunctive relief and revocation of licenses or permits.

Section 5. Additions or amendments to the Code when passed in such form as to indicate the intention to make the same a part of the Code shall be deemed to be incorporated in the Code, so that reference to the Code includes the additions and amendments.

Section 6. Ordinances adopted after March 12, 2018, that amend or refer to ordinances that have been codified in the Code shall be construed as if they amend or refer to like provisions of the Code.

Section 7. This ordinance shall become effective on and after its promulgation.

Said Ordinance was introduced on December 10th, 2018, notice of public hearing held on January 14th, 2019, the title having been read and the ordinance considered, after motion duly made and seconded, a record vote was taken and said vote was as follows:




