Meeting was called to order and Quorum established. Alderman George Garrett led the invocation and pledge.

Item 1 – Garbage Contract Award/Renewal/Extension

Mayor Willie announced Item and Village Attorney Roy Burns began by reading two Amendments regarding laws if in any case of a lawsuit arrive concerning this issue, including court cost and attorney fees would be included.

Mayor Willie then asked president of La. Waste Pro, Mr. Jesse Murphy whom was present if they offer Port-O-Potties and such.

Mr. Murphy began stating that they partner with a company for portable toilets and confirmed that they can provide the portable toilet services.

Mayor Willie then asked if the Board had any questions, there were no questions and Mayor Willie asked if the Board could make a motion to accept the contract with the amendments that were read by Attorney Burns.

Alderwoman Mathies made motion to accept contract from Waste Pro, motion seconded by Alderman Garrett. Motion carried (3 Yeas, 0 Nays)

Alderwoman Mathies then began with asking if the Village should assess an administration fee?

Mayor Willie stated that it does not cost us anything to bill garbage it is printed on the bill with the water and sewer and feel that a customer looking at a bill with a \$3.25 increase is better than seeing an almost \$5.00 increase especially with customer's that pay minimum bills and being that the biggest thing right now is trying not to raise customer's utility bills.

Alderman Garrett asked Municipal Clerk, Margra Steele what was her thoughts on this, and Ms. Steele stated that she is concerned that with late utility payments it can cause a problem with the garbage fund not having enough funding to cover the bills, due to garbage funding itself.

Alderman Dillon stated that he can see it both ways.

Alderman Garrett then stated that he could go both ways with it, but suggest that we just go like we are now and then six months down the road we will look at it again.

Alderwoman Mathies then stated that she was just making a suggestion and we can look at it from a citizen's point of view rather than a business.


