
**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 31, SECTION 31.8
REVOKING PORTION OF ST. CHARLES STREET**


BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Aldermen of the Village of Folsom, State of Louisiana that the dedication of the public street indicated below be and the same is hereby revoked and said street is declared permanently closed, abandoned and no longer needed for public purposes:


That portion of St. Charles Street lying between the northernmost right-of-way line of Louisiana Highway 40 (a portion of which is also known as Cleveland Street) and the southernmost right-of-way line of Camp Street, the revoked portion of St. Charles Street being situated between Square 34 to the west and Square 42 to the east, all in the Village of Folsom.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall take effect on and after its promulgation.


