BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Aldermen of the Village of Folsom, State of Louisiana that the dedication of the public street indicated below be and the same is hereby revoked and said street is declared permanently closed, abandoned and no longer needed for public purposes:

That portion of St. Charles Street lying between the northernmost right-of-way line of St. John Street and the southernmost right-of-way line of Willow Street, the revoked portion of St. Charles Street being situated between Square 38 to the west and Square 39 to the east, all in the Village of Folsom.
