VILLAGE OF FOLSOM**


BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Aldermen of the Village of Folsom, State of Louisiana that the dedication of the public street indicated below be and the same is hereby revoked and said street is declared permanently closed, abandoned and no longer needed for public purposes:


The westernmost forty six feet (46') of St. Claude Street lying between the southernmost right-of-way line of Broadway Street and the northernmost right-of-way line of Garfield Street.


BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Aldermen of the Village of Folsom, State of Louisiana that the dedication of the twenty (20.0') alley running north and south and bisecting Square 31, Village of Folsom, be and the same is hereby revoked and said alley is declared permanently closed, abandoned and no longer needed for public purposes.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall take effect on and after its promulgation.




